# AZ Medien|tv & radio and Blick Group become media partners of The Match for Africa 3

Zurich, 1 February 2017 – AZ Medien | tv & radio and Blick Group have become media partners of The Match for Africa 3. As the official host broadcaster, TV24 will broadcast the charity tennis match between Roger Federer and Andy Murray, the current ATP World No. 1, on Monday, 10 April 2017, live from Zurich's Hallenstadion. TV24, a national TV channel owned by AZ Medien AG, regularly puts out live productions in the world of elite sports, and can be watched nationwide. Ringier will act as media partner to The Match for Africa for the third time this year after 2010 and 2014 through Blick, and will produce the programme booklet for Exhibition Night, as well as reporting on the event.

Both AZ Medien | tv & radio and the Blick Group will support the Roger Federer Foundation in raising funds by promoting a donation week between 3 and 10 April 2017. The foundation established by 18-time Grand Slam champion and Career Grand Slam winner Roger Federer supports children living in poverty and promotes educational programmes in seven countries in southern Africa and Switzerland. The foundation's programmes currently support 275,000 children.

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#### Roger Federer Foundation



For more than twelve years, the Roger Federer Foundation has been engaging in education programmes for children living in poverty in Africa and Switzerland. It only works with carefully selected local organisations in long-term partnerships and seeks to bring about systemic change and have a sustainable impact. The Foundation therefore aims to enable and empower the local population to assume responsibility for finding solutions to problems while also determining the content, organisation and finances of these solutions. There are currently (as at 2016) 15 programmes running in Botswana, Malawi, Namibia, South Africa, Zambia, Zimbabwe and Switzerland, reaching 275,000 children with a total of approximately CHF 6.5 million. The Roger Federer Foundation aims to support one million children by 2018.
