Federer and Murray play benefit match for Roger Federer Foundation Sandra Studer and Pedro Pinto to present Exhibition Night Matthias Stach and Michael Lammer commentators for TV24

Zurich, 15 March 2017 – Tennis superstars in major contest on Swiss territory on 10 April: Andy Murray, current world number one, and Roger Federer, 18-time Grand Slam winner, will play each other in The Match for Africa 3 for the Roger Federer Foundation to a sold-out audience in the Hallenstadion, Zurich. The Exhibition Night will be broadcast live from 8 p.m. on TV24, La Télé and Tele Ticino. TV24 has a pre-match show lined up starting at 7.30 p.m. Sandra Studer and Pedro Pinto will be the moderators for the Exhibition Night. Commentators for the match are the German voice of tennis Matthias Stach and Michael Lammer.

Roger Federer thrilled his fans in the sold-out Hallenstadion two years ago with The Match for Africa and is now looking forward to a rerun with Andy Murray, the current world number one: "Andy has a big heart, especially when it comes to kids. I'm extremely grateful that he's coming to Zurich for the Roger Federer Foundation. I hope that he'll receive a warm welcome. He certainly deserves it." At the end of the year, Roger Federer will travel to Glasgow to take up Murray's invitation for a rematch. The Swiss player will play against the Scotsman in the Andy Murray Live exhibition match.

Live transmission throughout the country

The Match for Africa 3 will be broadcast live from the Hallenstadion, Zurich from 8 p.m. on Monday, 10 April 2017, on TV24. The Swiss tv channel will have an entertaining pre-match show starting at 7.30 p.m. Together with the organizer, the official TV-partner has been able to get on board two TV stations from French-and Italian-speaking Switzerland. In Western Switzerland, the match will be shown on La Télé starting at 8 p.m. In Ticino, tennis fans will be able to enjoy the extravaganza on Tele Ticino, also at 8 p.m. blick.ch take over the TV signal form TV24 and carry The Match for Africa 3 online starting at 8 p.m.

Sandra Studer and Pedro Pinto will present the Exhibition Night. Sandra Studer, the popular entertainer, is well known as the presenter of various television programs and as a singer in a number of musicals. "I am a big admirer of Roger Federer. And not just because of his incredible career. His classy, down-to-earth character sets a good example. It's a great honor for me to support him and his foundation in the Match for Africa." Pedro Pinto, who currently works as Managing Director of Communications at UEFA, spent nearly 15 years with CNN as a presenter and interviewed a multitude of sports personalities, including tennis stars such as Federer and Murray. "It is a pleasure and a privilege for me to take part in this special evening which I hope will contribute greatly to the Roger Federer Foundation and all of its projects in Africa. I have known Roger for several years and have always respected him immensely as an athlete and as a person."

The German tennis expert Matthias Stach, along with Michael Lammer, will provide the commentary on the match between Roger Federer and Andy Murray. Matthias Stach is Germany's voice of tennis and has received numerous awards as best tennis commentator. Michael Lammer played in a total of 13 Swiss Davis Cup Team matches in his career. Today the former professional tennis player is the head of young talents for U14 for Swiss Tennis.
